Walking with God in Nature

Saturday 8 December 2018

Start: 10 am at the Quarry Picnic Area car park about half a kilometre beyond the entry gate at Werribee Gorge State Park.

Finish: 4 pm.

We will walk uphill through dry eucalypt forest along the Werribee Gorge Circuit to a couple of lookout points. After morning tea we return to the carpark by the same way. We drive down to the Meikles Point Picnic area for lunch. From there we walk along the Werribee River and back again.

This is an opportunity for you to spend some reflective time walking in silence within a faith community in Nature. It offers you the experience of listening to God speaking to you in Nature.
